This allows greater flexibility in how those zones are used. You might choose to enjoy all zones until you go to bed, and then only use the security zones through the night. Or, save energy by only lighting the spaces that are actually being used at any given time.

If the WiFi signal is spotty, you may require an additional vendor or IT support, which Landscape East & West does not provide. However, we work in tandem with your IT support to make sure the IT person has the information needed to get the system set up properly.
